

KAHUNA FLAG INSTRUCTIONS

Cleat

Ground Stake Kit

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

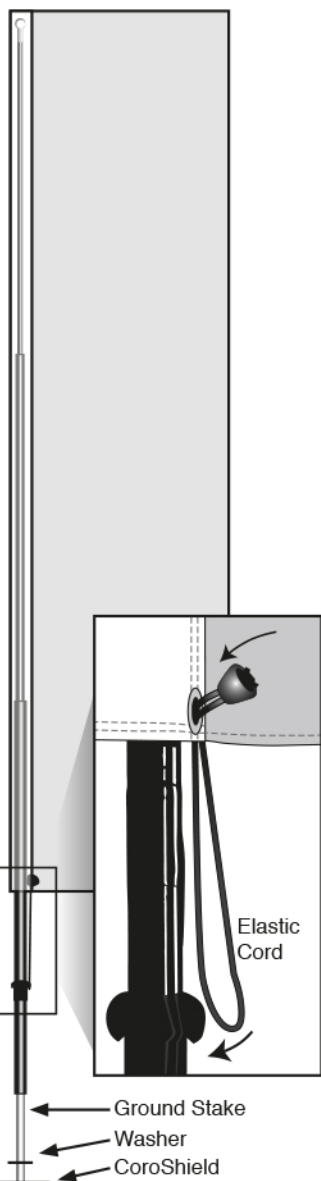
Before assembling your Kahuna flag pole kit, hammer the included fiberglass ground stake into the ground where you desire to fly your Kahuna flag, leaving approximately 1/2 of the ground stake exposed to support the assembled flag pole. Slide the CoroShield and metal washer over the ground stake.

TO PREVENT DAMAGE TO THE GROUND STAKE, USE A WOOD BLOCK BETWEEN THE GROUND STAKE AND YOUR HAMMER. USE GLOVES OR HANDCLOTH WHEN HANDLING, INSTALLING OR REMOVING FIBERGLASS GROUND STAKE.

WARNING: WHEN INSTALLING THE GROUND STAKE, EXERCISE CAUTION, AVOIDING ALL ELECTRIC, WATER, AND GAS LINES! ALSO, WHEN ERECTING THE FLAG, WATCH FOR OVERHEAD POWER LINES.

TO ASSEMBLE FLAG POLE HARDWARE:

1. Remove the flag pole sections from the plastic bag. (The 13' flag pole has three sections, and the 17' flag pole has four sections.) The bottom section has a tension clip, and the top section has a chrome ball at one end.
2. Take the middle section and insert the rubber-tipped end into the top of the bottom pole section. (The 17' pole will have two tapered middle sections.)
3. Insert the white end of the top section into the top of the middle pole section.
4. Unfurl your Kahuna flag and insert the top (ball end) of the assembled pole into the bottom open end of the Kahuna flag sleeve.
5. After sliding the flag pole the full length of the flag sleeve, thread the enclosed elastic cord through the bottom grommet of the flag sleeve and hook the looped end onto the cleat (see inset).
6. Slide pole over the installed ground stake. Your Kahuna flag is now fully installed.



IMPORTANT:

Use gloves when working with fiberglass ground stake.
